Fifty security fixes have been released for June 2021 Patch Tuesday by Microsoft to combat a range of vulnerabilities including six zero-days under known, active exploitation in the wild. <u>CVE-2021-31968</u> is also acknowledged as being a zero-day, however there are no known cases of active exploitation.

<u>CVE-2021-33742</u>, <u>CVE-2021-33739</u>, <u>CVE-2021-31199</u>, <u>CVE-2021-31201</u>, <u>CVE-2021-31955</u> & <u>CVE-2021-31956</u>.
