117 security fixes have been released for July 2021 Patch Tuesday by Microsoft, four of which relate to the recent PrintNightmare vulnerabilities known to be under active attack in the wild. Microsoft have issued thanks to multiple external research parties for their assistance in bringing these security flaws to light through MSTIC.
