AUGUST - PATCH TUESDAY



44 security fixes have been released for August 2021 Patch Tuesday by Microsoft – plus 7 for Microsoft Edge, 3 of which are zero-day vulnerabilities, 13 relate to Remote Code Execution (RCE) vulnerabilities and 8 revolved around information disclosure. One patch released deals with a new PrintSpooler vulnerability – which has been under intense scrutiny after PrintNightmare in June.
