OVERVIEW

Microsoft's Patch Tuesday update for October has addresses 81 vulnerabilities (including Microsoft Edge), including fixes for the four zero-day vulnerabilities. A breakdown of these cover areas including privilege escalation (21), security feature bypass (6), Remote Code Execution – RCE (20), information disclosure (13), Denial of Service – DoS (5) and spoofing (9). Cumulative updates for Windows 11 (KB5006674) and Windows 10 (KB5006670 & KB5006667) are also available for installation.

BREAKDOWN

Microsoft Windows:

- 81 updates in total
 - Zero Days <u>CVE-2021-40449</u>, <u>CVE-2021-40469</u>,
 <u>CVE-2021-41335</u>, <u>CVE-2021-41338</u>
- 3 rated CRITICAL
- 70 rated IMPORTANT
- 1 rated LOW
